Ticket cancellations

A full refund will be issued for cancellations received on or before 1 May 2016. Registration cancellations between 1 May and 15 May 2016 will receive a 50% refund on the registration fees. No refunds will be issued after 15 May 2016. Non-payment does not constitute cancellation. Want to give your ticket to someone else? Please contact us to nominate a substitute without additional fees. Substitutes can be nominated at all time, even during the conference.

Programme changes

The organization aims to present the most up to date programme, including any changes that might occur, via the conference website. Building the Future of Health reserves the right to change the conference programme at any time, without any notice, if and where necessary.

Force Majeure

The organization shall not be liable for any loss caused by the cancellation of the conference where such cancellation is due to Force Majeure. If the conference is cancelled, you will receive a full refund.

Partner and student tickets

Partner tickets are open to anyone who received a special partner discount code from the conference organization or one of the conference partners. After entering the discount code our ticket shop will unlock our special partner fee. Student tickets are open to students, PHD students, Postdoc researchers and young professionals graduated in the past three years (starting 1 January 2013).

Accommodation, reservations and capacity

Our capacity is limited by the conference venue. This means we cannot guarantee access to all (parallel) sessions. It is not possible to make a reservation for any of the sessions. We will do our utmost to program each session in the best possible conference room. Moreover, we provide a video link between different rooms during popular plenary sessions.
